## Century Music Boosters, Inc. Scholarship

*Mission Statement:* Music Boosters Scholarships are based on merit. They recognize individuals who demonstrate music excellence, outstanding effort and intellectual development, along with leadership and dependable service in support of the music program. The Scholarships are intended to provide financial aid toward college expenses.

*Scholarship(s)* will be awarded in the following amounts: \$500.00 scholarship(s) will be awarded. The selection process will be based on a point system, recommendation evaluation, and post HS music plan evaluation. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the Century Music Boosters, Inc.

*Mandatory Criteria for Applying:* The following are criteria that must be met to qualify the student as eligible for application:

- 1. Cumulative weighted GPA 3.75 academic average in music (instrumental and/or choral).
- 2. Participation in band, orchestra or chorus for at least three consecutive years.
- 3. Evidence of contribution/service to the Booster organization.
- 4. Acceptance into an accredited college or junior college.

### In order to be considered, a candidate must supply:

- 1. GPA in music/chorus by providing a copy of Home Access transcript, a summary of High School music career, and participation in outside music groups (complete application questions #1 through #7)
- 2. A typed paragraph summarizing the student's college plans and goals (see application #8 for directions)
- 3. Two letters of recommendation. None of the letters of recommendation can be from CHS <u>music</u> teacher. At least one of these letters must be from a Century High School faculty member. Music faculty will be asked to rate each applicant independent of this application. Relatives cannot write letters.

### Additional Considerations (listed in descending order of importance):

- 1. Participation and excellence in instrumental or choral music activities-symphonic band, concert band, marching band, orchestra, chorus, other ensembles, all-county and all-state bands, jazz band, solo/ensemble festival, school recitals, etc. Audition for all-county and all-state bands, orchestras, or chorus regardless of whether or not the student earns a seat, will also be considered.
- 2. Contribution to the music program by promoting teamwork, cooperation, spirit, leadership etc.
- 3. Participation in music activities outside of school- non CHS band camps, special ensembles, drum corps, private accompanists, church music groups, etc.

*The Music Boosters' Scholarship Selection Committee is composed of:* a chairperson and four (4) voting members. The four (4) members will include at least one parent from each of the freshman, sophomore, and junior classes. The chairperson can be a parent from any class and is the only member of the committee that will know the identity of the applicants. Except for the chairperson, the Scholarship Selection Committee will remain anonymous. The decision of the committee is final.

#### Additional Information:

- ~This is a scholarship based on past excellence in music independent of the student's intended college major.
- ~ Information provided in this application will be verified with CHS Music Boosters records.
- ~Announcements of the winners will be made at the End of the Year Awards Ceremony.
