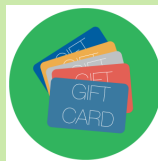

Dear parents, guardians, chaperones, and students,

4. Complete the security exercise under the Trip ID field.
5. Enter all requested information.

7. Submit your completed form.

After you register, you will receive a confirmation email verifying completion of your registration and an invitation to join MyTrip where you can access Discovery for Credit. Here, students can complete the required course work to get academic credit.
